

RESOLUTION 050112-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, TEXAS, CANCELING THE MAY 12, 2012 REGULAR ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS AND MAYOR TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE AT-LARGE POSITIONS AND DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES ELECTED TO OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Florence, Texas is a General Law Type A Municipality located in Williamson County, and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Law Type A General Election has been ordered for May 12, 2012; for the purpose of electing TWO Council members and Mayor to the At-Large positions to serve on the City Council for the City of Florence; and

WHEREAS, no proposition is to appear in the ballot in that election; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified, in writing, that the candidates on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy has passed; and

WHEREAS, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that

SECTION 1. The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 12, 2012 General Election, is hereby declared elected to office, and shall be issued a certificate of election:

Mary Condon- Mayor
Denise Deichmann- Alderman
Debra Bartos Cahill- Alderwoman

SECTION 2. The City Secretary is directed to post a copy of this Resolution at each designated polling place on or before May 12, 2012.
