of network nodes and node support poles pursuant to chapter 284 of the Texas local government code; providing city procedures for applications for permits; establishing time periods for approval of permit applications; providing application fees and annual public right-of-way rental rates; providing restrictions on placement of network nodes and node support poles in municipal parks, residential areas, historic districts and design districts; providing indemnity for the city; providing repealing and savings clauses; proving a Texas Open Meetings Act clause; and providing an effective date of September 1, 2017. Lesa Ragsdale seconded the motion. Mayor Mary Condon asked to poll the Council.
