## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS RSP AGREEMENT APPLICATION WHICH SHALL INCLUDE HRA, PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES AND DISASTER PROGRAM THRU THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE HOME PROGRAM RSP AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Florence desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Florence, TEXAS:

- 1. That a request and application to the Home Investment Partnerships Program for participation in the HOME RSP Program is authorized to be filed on behalf of the City with the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
- That the City directs and designates the City Mayor, Mary Condon, as the City's Chief Executive Officers and Authorized Representatives to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the HOME Program, including execution of the City's HOME RSP Agreement.
- 3. That it be stated that the City of Florence is committing to matching funds, if applicable, consisting of waived fees, in-kind services, and cash as a contribution toward the activities of this HOME project in the amount required in 10 TAC, Chapter 23, rules at the time an activity is made and approved in the system. Based on the rules in 10 Tac Chapter 23, The city of Florence will not be obligated to match funds due to the city's current population base of 1262 per the 2017 estimated American Fact Finder census report. There is no match for any city that is under the population of 3000.
- 4. That is be stated that the City of Florence is committing \$40,000 for the HOME RSP agreement application in unencumbered cash reserves to the project to facilitate the administration of the program during the TDHCA disbursement process.
